



Back to Basics is a series of courses that give us a foundation for the faith we live together at All Saints. It's not indoctrination but a chance to roll up our sleeves, learn, discuss and apply the core pieces of who we are as Christians and Episcopalians. Classes are offered on Wednesday evenings in the Parish Hall with light refreshments. There is a \$20-per-person fee to cover refreshments and class materials; scholarships are available—talk to Suzanne.

These classes are important and as such we ask that you commit to attend all the sessions offered within each module. If you are unable to attend, you'll have a chance again, as the courses will be offered in an ongoing rotation.

Basic Anglicanism

Everything you need to know about the Episcopal Church, Anglican Communion, our worship, how we are ordered, how All Saints works, how Anglicans “do theology” where we come from and where we are heading. You're guaranteed to learn something new, even if you've been an Episcopalian all your life. No fee for this course.

Basic Bible

The Bible is an epic love story and our primary source for God's enduring presence in creation. In addition to a basic orientation to the Bible, a map of the broad themes of the bible and timeline of events, participants will learn and practice lectio divina, a method of praying with scripture on a daily basis with a goal of having a life infused with God's love for us.

Basic Christianity

Following Christ is about trusting in God's presence in the world and in our lives in amazing ways. This class will look at the basic concepts of Christianity and what they mean for our lives: Creation. Incarnation. Crucifixion. Resurrection. Life in Christ. The end times. The Body of Christ.

Basic Discipleship

What does it mean to walk it? Each week we will examine on the of the holy habits of discipleship: Prayer. Worship. Learning. Service. Giving. Participants will be linked as prayer

partners, and much of the class is small group work of support and accountability in following Jesus in our daily lives. At the end of class, all will be invited to join ongoing discipleship groups to continue the journey.
